

Vocabulary- English vocabulary such as topic specific vocabulary, idiomatic expressions, basic nouns and verbs, high frequency words, and general academic vocabulary necessary for basic everyday life and school life.

Specific Indicator (the student will)	Illustrative Examples
Understand and use general academic vocabulary (nouns and verbs) involved in subject areas	Math terms: <i>E.g. numbers, operations, shapes and patterns</i> Science terms: <i>E.g. earth, space, weather</i> Geography terms: <i>E.g. directions (northeast, etc.), map terms (legend, key, etc.), city features (buildings, parks, etc.)</i>
Introduce, understand and use the most common idioms, slang, and reductions	<i>E.g. piece of cake, driving me crazy, two peas in a pod, knock on wood, green thumb</i> <i>E.g. (slang changes) sic, gym strip, phat, , yo, owns it, E.g. gonna, wanna, hafta, 'sup?</i> <i>E.g. idioms in P.A. announcements such as: "Let's get crackin'!"</i>
Understand and use high frequency words necessary for everyday life.	Greetings, requests, confirmation, questions, refusals, descriptions, introductions, compliments, clarification, repetition, narrations, etc.
